Dear Tony,


In May of 2009, an article in the Richmond Times-Dispatch talked about how you were one of the first people contacted by Tony Bennett when he was hired as the new men's basketball coach at the University of Virginia. I had recently been named the new head coach at St. Christopher's School in Richmond, VA and decided to do the exact same thing as Coach Bennett.

After our first meeting, I was impressed that you took the time to get to know me even though I was an unproven, first-year high school coach. We talked about how basketball could be used to make a positive impact in the lives of young people, and you emphasized how important qualities such as honesty, loyalty, and personal accountability were the staples of your AAU program for the past twenty-five years.

In the years since, I have been fortunate to work with you and many other good people connected to the Squires' organization, including three quality young men who played for you and attended St. Christopher's. Rob Vozenilek was an All-Prep League performer who walked-on at the University of Virginia. Jermaine Johnson was the Prep League Co-Player of the Year in 2012 and earned a Division I scholarship to Canisius College. Rodney Williams was the Prep League Player of the Year in 2013 and committed to Drexel University after receiving nearly 30 Division I scholarship offers. He also graduated as the all-time leading scorer in St. Christopher's history with over 1,250 points.

When we first met, I asked if you knew a good person that might like to join me at St. Christopher's as an assistant coach. You recommended one of your coaches, Hannibal Tuck, and fortunately Coach Tuck has been at St. Christopher's the past four years. He is an outstanding basketball coach, mentor, and friend. He coaches for the right reasons; he loves basketball and helping young men maximize their potential. Coach Tuck has been integral part of our success.

Congratulations to you and the entire Squires' organization on 25 years of remarkable achievements in AAU basketball. It is a pleasure to now be included in the many who have worked with you to help some great kids strive for and reach their dreams as student-athletes.
